General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Joseph Edward Gargan (Respondent) because he created a fraudulent annuity then retained funds received from the client and because he no longer has a resident license in good standing in his home state. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On January 26, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
 A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
 Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Arlington, VA 22201-3866. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail to e-mail addresses associated with Respondent.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, 4054.301 and 4101.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that any licenses held by Joseph Edward Gargan are revoked. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Joseph Edward Gargan. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.301, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

- 1. Joseph Edward Gargan (Gargan), individual identification number 496841, holds a non-resident life agent license originally issued by the Department on June 4, 2015.
- Gargan has a Texas non-resident license because he lives in Virginia. This license type requires that Gargan have a resident license in good standing in his home state.
- 3. Gargan created a fraudulent annuity, purportedly from his employer, for the client's use in paying off the client's settlement obligations and then retained the funds received from the client for his own use.
- 4. Gargan voluntarily surrendered his insurance license in his resident state of Virginia as part of a settlement agreement.

5. Gargan failed to notify the Department of the administrative action taken by Virginia within 30 days.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Gargan misappropriated and converted to his own use money belonging to an insurer, insured, enrollee, or beneficiary as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b) (4).
- 2. Gargan has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 3. Gargan failed to notify the Department or deliver a copy of any document or order from another state, pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code § 81.003, within 30 days of the occurrence of the suspension or revocation of his right to transact business.
- 4. Gargan failed to notify the Department of the administrative action taken by an insurance regulator of another state, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4001.252(a)(3).
- 5. Gargan does not hold a license in good standing as an agent in his state of residence, as required by Tex. INS. CODE § 4056.052, and is no longer eligible to hold a non-resident license in Texas.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Gargan's license and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
