General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against David Dwayne Womack (Respondent) because he: misappropriated, converted to his own use, or illegally withheld money belonging to an insurer; engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices; willfully violated an insurance law of this state; failed to respond to the department's multiple inquiries; and, failed to notify the department on a monthly basis of a change to his mailing address. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On January 12, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Grand Prairie, Texas 75051. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail and to two additional addresses associated with Respondent: Dallas, Texas 75237 and Waxahachie, Texas 75165.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against David Dwayne Womack. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:


Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 912.25 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

<u>Licensure</u>

- David Dwayne Womack (Womack), individual identification number 108073, previously held a limited lines agent license which became inactive on August 17, 1994.
- 2. Womack previously held a county mutual agent license with the department, which expired on June 30, 2020. Womack failed to renew in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE § 4003.007.
- 3. Presently, Womack holds an active general lines agent license with a life, accident, health, and HMO qualification, issued by the department on October 4, 2018.



Misappropriation, Conversion, or Illegal Withholding of Money Belonging to Insurer

- 4. Since August 21, 2018, Womack held an appointment with Reliable Life Insurance Company (Reliable) to perform the acts of an agent on Reliable's behalf. On August 27, 2019, Reliable cancelled Womack's appointment for cause.
- 5. An audit conducted by Reliable after that cancellation identified \$2,433.26 in customer premiums that Womack collected, but failed to pay Reliable between July 2019 and August 2019. These funds were due and owing to Reliable.
- 6. The amount of Womack's cash bond with Reliable, \$876.96, did not cover the entire amount of premiums due to Reliable.
- 7. Reliable maintains that \$1,556.30 in customer premiums is still owed to Reliable, along with \$43.62 in postage used in order to collect that debt. In total, Reliable maintains that \$1,599.92 is the remaining balance owed to Reliable.
- 8. Womack misappropriated, converted, or illegally withheld \$2,433.26 from Reliable, and continues to owe Reliable \$1,599.92.

Failure to Respond to an Inquiry

- 9. On July 15, 2020, the department mailed a request for information to Womack about the above matters, informing him that he must respond no later than 15 days after receipt of the inquiry. Womack received the request for information on July 20, 2020, at one of Womack's address of record with the department. Womack did not respond to the department's inquiry.
- 10. On September 9, 2020, the department mailed another request for information to Womack, informing him that he must respond no later than 15 days after receipt of the inquiry. Womack received the request for information on September 14, 2020, at one of Womack's addresses of record with the department. Womack did not respond to the department's inquiry.
- 11. On September 30, 2020, the department mailed another request for information to Womack informing him that he must respond no later than 15 days after receipt of the inquiry. Womack received the request for information on October 5, 2020,

at an address Womack provided to the department by telephone. Womack did not respond to the department's inquiry.

Failure to Notify Department of Change in Mailing Address

- 12. During a September 30, 2020, phone conversation with department staff, Womack provided information indicating that his mailing address of record with the department was no longer current. Womack was instructed to update his mailing address.
- 13. As of January 7, 2021, Womack failed to timely update his mailing address of record with the department.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Womack has willfully violated an insurance law of this state, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
- 2. Womack has misappropriated, converted to his own use, or illegally withheld money belonging to an insurer, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(4).
- 3. Womack has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 4. Womack failed to respond to the department's multiple written inquiries not later than the 15th day after the date of each inquiry, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 38.001.
- 5. Womack failed to notify the department on a monthly basis of a change to his mailing address, in violation of Tex. INS. CODE § 4001.252(a)(1).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

1. revoking David Dwayne Womack's license; and


2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
