## General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines property and casualty license should be issued to Erick Bernard Davis (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

## **Findings of Fact**

## Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On March 3, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

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Hill, TX 75104. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

## **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4101.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

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#### Order

It is ordered that Erick Bernard Davis's application is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

You have the right to appear at this hearing and to be represented by an attorney.

#### **ORIGINAL PETITION**

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Erick Bernard Davis's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

#### **Jurisdiction**

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4051.051, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.502; and Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021 – 53.023 Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

## **Factual Allegations**

# **License Application**

- 1. On September 4, 2019, Erick Bernard Davis (Davis) applied for a general lines property and casualty license to be issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI).
- 2. On November 14, 2019, TDI proposed to deny Davis's application based on his criminal history. Davis appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing on December 10, 2019.

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## Previous Licensure

- 3. Davis, individual identification number 693120, held a general lines agent license with a life, accident, health & HMO qualification issued by the Texas Department of Insurance on July 10, 2006, and a property and casualty qualification issued by the department on May 12, 2011.
- 4. The Texas Department of Insurance revoked Davis's license on August 26, 2014.

## Criminal History

- 5. On June 16, 2003, Davis pleaded guilty to the Class B Misdemeanor offense of Failure to Identify Oneself to a Peace Officer in Cause No. 1167945 in the County Criminal Court at Law No. 2 in Harris County, Texas for an offense occurring on April 13, 2003. Davis received 3 days of confinement and was ordered to pay a fine.
- 6. On December 6, 2005, Davis pleaded guilty to the Class A Misdemeanor offense of Assault-Family Member in Cause No. 1336634 in Harris County, Texas for an offense occurring on November 2, 2005. Davis received 2 days of confinement.
- 7. On May 31, 2012, following a guilty plea, Davis was adjudicated guilty of the federal felony offenses of Conspiracy to Commit Bank Fraud and Aiding and Abetting Bank Fraud in United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas, Cause No. 11 CR 445, and sentenced to 2 years of probation.

## Previous Administrative Action and License Revocation

- 8. On March 12, 2014, the department filed a Notice of Hearing in SOAH Docket No. 454-14-2633.C to consider disciplinary action against Davis. In the Notice of Hearing, the department considered disciplinary action against Davis for being convicted of felony conspiracy to commit bank fraud and bank fraud, aiding and abetting. Davis also failed to complete 30 hours of continuing education during the 2011 to 2013 continuing education reporting period.
- 9. On August 26, 2014, the Texas Commissioner of Insurance signed Order No. 3508, revoking Davis's general, life, accident, and health license and general property and casualty license.

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# **Legal Allegations**

- 1. Davis has committed an act for which a license may be denied pursuant to Tex. INS. Code § 4005.101(b) because he has been convicted of a felony, as contemplated by Tex. INS. Code § 4005.101(b)(8) and Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021(d).
- 2. Davis has committed a felony that directly relates to the business of insurance, as contemplated in Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021-53.023.
- 3. Davis has committed a felony offense, as contemplated in 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.502(e).
- 4. Davis committed an offense that TDI considers to be of such serious nature that it is of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure or authorization, as contemplated by 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(e)(1).
- 5. Davis had a previous license revoked by the Commissioner of Insurance, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.105(b).
- 6. Davis has failed to show good cause why the revocation of the previous license should not be considered a bar to the issuance of a new license, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.105(c).
- 7. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
  - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
  - b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
  - c. considers a fraud offense to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1).

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8. Davis has been convicted of a felony involving dishonesty or breach of trust, as specified in 18 U.S.C § 1033 and requiring written consent from the commissioner of insurance to engage or participate in the business of insurance.

# **Relief Sought**

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Erick Bernard Davis's license application and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
