General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification should be issued to Kenneth Shaw, Jr. (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On April 15, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

Killeen Texas 76543. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail to two additional addresses associated with Respondent.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055; and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

Order

It is ordered that Kenneth Shaw, Jr.'s application is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement and/or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Kenneth Shaw Jr.'s license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

License Application

- 1. Kenneth Shaw Jr. (Shaw) submitted an application for a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification on July 29, 2019.
- 2. The department proposed to deny Shaw's application on August 28, 2019, based on his criminal history. Shaw timely appealed the decision and requested a hearing.

Criminal History

3. Shaw committed misdemeanor Possession of Marijuana, Two Ounces or Less, on December 31, 2004. He pled guilty to the same in Cause No. CR-0522883 in County

Court at Law, Hopkins County, Texas, on June 27, 2007, and was sentenced to one hundred twenty days confinement and a fine of \$1,000.

- 4. Shaw committed misdemeanor Theft of \$500 \$1,500 on June 3, 2005. He pled guilty to the same in Cause No. CR-0523315 on June 27, 2007, and was sentenced to one hundred twenty days confinement and a fine of \$1,000.
- 5. Shaw pled guilty to the following state jail felonies on October 5, 2005, in the 8th Judicial District Court of Hopkins County, Texas. He was sentenced to sixteen months confinement for each of the following charges, served concurrently:
 - a. On November 10, 2003, Shaw committed Manual Delivery of a Controlled Substance Less Than One Gram, in Cause No. 0417783.
 - b. On January 14, 2004, Shaw committed Manual Delivery of a Controlled Substance Less Than One Gram, in Cause No. 0417785.
 - c. On January 15, 2004, Shaw committed Manual Delivery of a Controlled Substance Less Than One Gram, in Cause No. 0417784.
 - d. On January 31, 2004, Shaw committed Manual Delivery of a Controlled Substance Less Than One Gram, in Cause No. 0417786.
 - e. On March 5, 2004, Shaw committed Manual Delivery of a Controlled Substance Less Than One Gram, in Cause No. 0417787.
 - f. On December 31, 2004, Shaw Evaded Arrest or Detention with a Vehicle, in Cause No. 0518112.
 - g. On April 18, 2005, Shaw committed Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse, in Cause No. 0518255.
 - h. On May 25, 2005, Shaw committed Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse, in Cause No. 0518258.
 - i. On May 26, 2005, Shaw committed Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse, in Cause No. 0518254.

- j. On May 26, 2005, Shaw committed Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse, in Cause No. 0518256.
- k. On June 6, 2005, Shaw committed Burglary of a Building, in Cause No. 0518252.
- I. On June 12, 2005, Shaw Evaded Arrest or Detention with a Vehicle, in Cause No. 0518259.
- 6. On May 7, 2005, Shaw committed the state jail felony of Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse. On October 5, 2005, he pled guilty to the same in the 8th Judicial District Court of Hopkins County, Texas, in Cause No. 0518257, and was sentenced to two years confinement, probated for five years. On July 17, 2008, Shaw's probation was revoked and he was sentenced to twenty three months confinement due to his arrest for Felon in Possession of a Firearm on July 2, 2008.
- 7. On January 15, 2010, Shaw was convicted of Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Ammunition by the United States District Court, Eastern District of Texas, in Case No. 4:08-CR-188, and was sentenced to 188 months confinement followed by a five year term of supervised release. On September 27, 2018, the judgment was amended, and Shaw was sentenced to a term of 35 months confinement followed by a three year term of supervised release.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Shaw has committed acts for which a license may be denied pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated in Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
- 2. Shaw engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 3. Shaw is a convicted felon, as contemplated by 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d), Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8), and Tex. Occ. CODE §§ 53.021-53.025.
- 4. Shaw committed offenses which directly relate to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation, as contemplated by Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021(a)(1) and 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(d).

- 5. Shaw committed offenses the department considers to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as contemplated by 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.502(e)(1), (e)(4)(E), (e)(4)(F), and (e)(4)(G).
- 6. Texas Department of Insurance guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize the department:
 - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or misdemeanor that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation;
 - c. considers any offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element to be of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure; and
 - d. considers the offenses of credit card or debit card abuse, burglary, theft, and delivery of a controlled substance to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure.
- 7. Shaw was convicted of felonies involving dishonesty or breach of trust, as specified in 18 U.S.C. § 1033 and requires written consent from the commissioner of insurance to engage or participate in the business of insurance.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Kenneth Shaw Jr.'s license application and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
