General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent life, accident, health, and HMO license should be issued to Elias Hernandez (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 9, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

 Houston, TX 77072, and to the electronic mail address on file with the department.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction pursuant to Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101, and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(e); and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing pursuant to Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default pursuant to 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true pursuant to 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Elias Hernandez's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4054.051, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; Tex. Occ. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023; and Tex. Gov'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Application

- 1. Elias Hernandez (Hernandez) applied for a general lines agent life, accident, health, and HMO license with the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) on July 17, 2020.
- 2. On September 23, 2020, TDI proposed to deny the license based on Hernandez's criminal history.
- 3. On October 26, 2020, TDI received Hernandez's request for a hearing on this matter.

Criminal History

- 4. On December 7, 1999, Hernandez was convicted by a jury of his peers, of three first degree felony offenses for aggravated sexual assault of a child in cause numbers 98-CR 1006, 1007, and 1008.
- 5. Hernandez's three convictions are for crimes listed under Chapter 22 of the penal code, specifically, Tex. Penal Code § 22.021.
- 6. Hernandez's three convictions are for crimes listed under Article 42A.054 of the criminal procedure code, specifically, TEX. CODE CRIM. PRO. 42A.054(a)(9).
- 7. Hernandez's convictions require him to register as a sex offender, as contemplated by Tex. Code Crim. Pro. § 62.001(5)(a).

Legal Allegations

- 1. Hernandez committed acts, namely felony convictions, that allow the department to deny a license application under Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(8).
- 2. Hernandez has been convicted of offenses listed in Article 42A.054, that allow the department to disqualify him from receiving a license under Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021(a)(2).
- 3. Hernandez been convicted of sexually violent offenses, defined by Article 62.001 of the code of criminal procedure, that allow the department to disqualify him from receiving a license under Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021(a)(3).
- 4. Hernandez has committed offenses that directly relate to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed profession, as contemplated by Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021(a)(1) and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(d), specifically:
 - a. The department considers Hernandez's crimes to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure because they are felony offenses involving moral turpitude or breach of fiduciary duty, as contemplated by 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502 (e)(3).

b. The department considers Hernandez's crimes to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure because they are offenses containing the essential elements of felony assault described by chapter 22 of the penal code, as contemplated by 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(e)(4)(B).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Elias Hernandez's license application and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law.
