General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether both a County Mutual license and a General Lines Life, Accident, and Health license should be issued to Kristen Nicole Dominguez (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license applications.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On December 17, 2021, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

Wichita Falls, TX 76308. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4101.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055; and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that Kristen Nicole Dominguez's applications are denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Kristen Nicole Dominguez's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4051.201, 4054.051 and 28 Tex. ADMIN. Code §§ 1.502; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021–53.023; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Prior Licensure

 Kristen Nicole Dominguez (Dominguez), individual identification no. 1765813, previously held a temporary general lines-LAH agent license and a temporary county mutual agent license with the department, which were both cancelled on November 29, 2021.

Misrepresentation on License Application

2. In both of her license applications, Dominguez falsely answered "No" to the following question:

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Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgement withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?

License Application

- 3. On September 23, 2020, Dominguez submitted an application to the department for a county mutual and general lines LAH license.
- 4. The department proposed to deny Dominguez's application on March 24, 2021, based on her criminal history and failure to disclose her criminal history. Dominguez appealed that decision and made a written request for hearing.

<u>Criminal History</u>

- 5. On or about August 28, 2015, Dominguez pled guilty to the felony offense of Secure Execution of Document by Deception (\$1,500-\$20,000) in Cause No. 55434-A in the 30th District Court in Wichita County, Texas, for an offense occurring on June 13, 2012. Dominguez received 5 years Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision.
- 6. On September 9, 2020, the court entered an order discharging Dominguez from Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Dominguez has committed an act for which a license may be denied under Tex. INS. CODE ANN. § 4005. 101, as contemplated in Tex. INS. CODE ANN. § 4001.105(3).
- 2. Dominguez has been sentenced to deferred adjudication probation for a felony offense involving moral turpitude, as contemplated in Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021-53.023.
- 3. Dominguez intentionally made a material misstatement in a license application, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(2).
- 4. Dominguez attempted to obtain a license by fraud or misrepresentation, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(3).

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- 5. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that the department:
 - a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or misdemeanor that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation;
 - c. considers the offense of Secure Execution of Document by Deception (\$1,500-\$20,000to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(1).

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Kristen Nicole Dominguez's license application and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
