General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license should be issued to Ashley Nichole Seideman (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- 1. On February 2, 2022, the department filed a First Amended Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition filed as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached First Amended Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the First Amended Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, , Amarillo, Texas 79102.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the First Amended Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

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Order

It is ordered that Ashley Nichole Seideman's application is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to deny Ashley Nichole Seideman's (Seideman) license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051; 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021–53.023; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

License Application

- 1. On October 16, 2020, Seideman applied for a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification to the department.
- 2. TDI proposed to deny Seideman's application on December 16, 2020, based on her criminal history. Seideman appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing.

Criminal History

3. On December 30, 2015, Seideman pled guilty to Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse Elderly, a third-degree felony, in Case No. 71,166-D in the 320th District Court of

Potter County, Texas. Seideman was placed on four years deferred adjudication. On January 6, 2020, Seideman was discharged from probation. The Court further ordered that the plea be withdrawn and the verdict set aside.

- 4. On January 12, 2016, Seideman pled guilty to Credit Card or Debit Card Abuse Elderly, a third-degree felony, in Case No. 26193C, in the 251st District Court of Randall County, Texas. Seideman was placed on deferred adjudication for three years. On January 28, 2020, Seideman was discharged from probation. The Court further ordered the plea be withdrawn and the verdict set aside.
- 5. On June 29, 2016, Seideman pled guilty to misdemeanor Theft Over \$100 and Under \$750, in No. 2016-00174, in the County Court of Deaf Smith County, Texas. Seideman was sentenced to pay a fine of \$200 and was confined in the Deaf Smith County Jail for 30 days.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Seideman committed acts for which a license may be denied under TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101:
 - a. Based on her prior criminal history, she engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).
 - b. Seideman is considered to have been convicted of the two felony offenses because she completed the period of supervision less than five years before the date she applied for the license, and after consideration of the factors described by Sections 53.022 and 53.023(a) of the Texas Occupations Code, TDI determined Seideman may pose a continued threat to public safety or employment of her in the licensed occupation would create a situation in which she has an opportunity to repeat the prohibited conduct. Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021.
- 2. In accordance with the requirements of Texas Occupations Code § 53.025, the department has developed guidelines relating to the matters which the department will consider in determining whether to grant, deny, suspend, or revoke any license or authorization under its jurisdiction. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502.

- 3. Seideman committed an offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element; a felony offense involving moral turpitude; an offense with the essential elements of a theft offense, as described by Penal Code, Chapter 31. 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502(e)(1), (3), and 4(E) and Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.025.
- 4. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. Considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. May refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
 - c. Considers credit card abuse elderly or debit card abuse elderly and theft to each be an offense to be of such a serious nature that they are of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. Denying Seideman's license application; and
- 2. Imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
