#### General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether an adjuster license, designated home state Texas, should be issued to Ryan D. Pugh (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

#### **Findings of Fact**

#### Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On March 22, 2022, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit
   A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of
   Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

Barberton, Ohio 44203. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4101.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.



FAILURE TO FILE A WRITTEN RESPONSE BY THIS DEADLINE SHALL ENTITLE TDI TO SEEK DISPOSITION BY DEFAULT UNDER 1 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 155.501 AND 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 AND 1.89.

#### **ORIGINAL PETITION**

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Ryan D. Pugh's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

#### **Jurisdiction**

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4102.051, 28 Tex. ADMIN. Code §§ 1.502; and Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021–53.023 and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

# **Factual Allegations**

# **License Application**

- 1. On July 19, 2020, Ryan D. Pugh (Pugh) applied for an adjuster license, designated home state Texas, to be issued by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI).
- 2. On October 30, 2020, TDI proposed to deny Pugh's application based on his criminal history. Pugh appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing that was received on December 2, 2020.

# **Criminal History**

3. On May 31, 2006, Pugh pled guilty to the felony offense of Aggravated Possession of Drugs in Cause No. 2006-05-1874 in the Common Pleas Court in Summit

- County, Ohio for an offense occurring on May 15, 2006. Pugh received two years Community Control.
- 4. On February 15, 2007, Pugh pled guilty to the felony offense of Aggravated Possession of Drugs in Cause No. 2006-10-3852(B) in the Common Pleas Court in Summit County, Ohio for an offense occurring on October 23, 2006. Pugh received two years Community Control.
- 5. On June 25, 2008, Pugh pled guilty to one count of the felony offense of Receiving Stolen Property and one count of the misdemeanor offense of Petty Theft in Cause No. 2008-04-1180 in the Common Pleas Court in Summit County, Ohio for offenses occurring on April 7, 2008. Pugh received 18 months Community Control.
- 6. On December 11, 2009, Pugh pled guilty to one count of the felony offense of Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug and one count of the felony offense of Forgery in Cause No. 2009-08-2608(B) in the Common Pleas Court in Summit County, Ohio for an offense occurring on August 13, 2009. Pugh received one year confinement for each count, to be served concurrently.
- 7. On December 28, 2009, Pugh pled guilty to the felony offense of Deception to Obtain a Dangerous Drug in Cause No. 2009-11-3373 in the Common Pleas Court in Summit County, Ohio for an offense occurring on November 4, 2009. Pugh received 15 months confinement.

#### **Legal Allegations**

- 1. Pugh has committed an act for which a license may be denied pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b) because he has been convicted of a felony, as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(8) and Tex. Occ. CODE § 53.021(d).
- 2. Pugh has committed a felony that directly relates to the business of insurance, as contemplated by Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021-53.023.
- 3. Pugh has committed a felony offense, as contemplated by 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502 (e).
- 4. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:

- a. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
- b. may refuse to issue an original license if the department determines that the applicant has committed a felony or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
- c. considers a theft offense to be of such a serious nature that it is of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure. 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(e)(4)(F).
- 5. Pugh has been convicted of a felony involving dishonesty or breach of trust, as specified in 18 U.S.C. § 1033 and requiring written consent from the commissioner of insurance to engage or participate in the business of insurance.

#### **Relief Sought**

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Ryan D. Pugh's license application; and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
