### General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a general lines agent license should be issued to Leonard Paul Lowe (Respondent). Respondent did not appear at the hearing on the merits. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

### **Findings of Fact**

### Failure to Appear at Hearing on the Merits

- 1. On May 13, 2022, the Texas Department of Insurance filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department,

Mansfield, Texas 76063-4027. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by eFile.

4. After receiving proper notice of the date, time, and location of the hearing on the merits, Respondent failed to appear for the hearing on August 9, 2022, as shown in the record in SOAH Docket No. 454-22-2675.

### **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4005.105, and 4051.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055; and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to appear in person or by legal representative at the hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

### ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Leonard Paul Lowe's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

### **Jurisdiction**

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4005.105, and 4051.051; Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Occ. Code § 53.021-53.023.

### **Factual Allegations**

## Licensure and Previous Disciplinary History

- 1. Leonard Paul Lowe (Lowe), individual identification number 277430, previously held a general lines agent license with a property and casualty qualification and a life, accident, and health qualification, originally issued by the department on June 12, 1997.
- 2. Paul Lowe Insurance Agency of Texas, Inc. (Lowe Insurance Agency), firm identification number 22283, previously held a general lines agency license with a property and casualty qualification and a life, accident, and health qualification, originally issued by the department on December 10, 2004.
- 3. Lowe conducted his insurance business through Lowe Insurance Agency.

4. On December 5, 2012, the commissioner of insurance entered Official Order No. 2090 which revoked Lowe's general lines agent license, his agency license, and ordered Lowe to pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000.

### **License Application**

- 5. On January 31, 2021, Lowe submitted an application for a general lines agent license with a property and casualty qualification.
- 6. On February 23, 2021, the department proposed to deny Lowe's application based on Lowe's prior disciplinary history and his criminal history. Lowe appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing.

### Licensee Misconduct

- 7. Official Order No. 2090 adopted the administrative law judge's (ALJ) Proposal for Decision (PFD), and included the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:
  - a. Lowe received premium payments from W.O.E. Construction, also known as Washed Out Enterprises, Inc. (Washed Out), in an amount of \$18,555.43 for an endorsement which increased the exposure to its commercial general liability policy. Lowe failed to remit any of the payments made by Washed Out to the insurer. The insurer honored the policy but never received money for the additional exposure. Lowe owes the insurer at least \$5,500 in unearned premiums and commissions.
  - b. Lowe received a premium payment for Phillips Management Company in the amount of \$6,076.72 for insurance coverage. Lowe failed to remit the premium payment made by Phillips Management Company to the insurer. The insurer honored the policy even though the insurer never received the premium payment from Lowe. Lowe owes the insurer for the premiums withheld on the policy.
  - c. Lowe received a premium payment for Action Transmission in the amount of \$3,399.39 for insurance coverage. Lowe cashed the check but Action Transmission was unable to obtain proof of insurance or any type of coverage from Lowe. Lowe failed to reimburse Action Transmission the premium payment paid.

- d. Lowe misappropriated, converted to his own use, and illegally withheld money belonging to an insurer and an insured.
- e. Lowe engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices.

## **Criminal History**

8. On May 11, 2016, Lowe pled guilty to the offense of misapplication of fiduciary property in the amount of \$20,000 to \$100,000, a third degree felony, in case no. 1423189D, in the 396th District Court of Tarrant County, Texas. Lowe was placed on deferred adjudication for five years and was ordered to pay \$23,218.63 in restitution. On December 28, 2018, Lowe was discharged from deferred adjudication.

## **Legal Allegations**

- 1. Lowe committed acts for which a license may be denied pursuant to Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated in Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
- 2. Lowe willfully violated an insurance law of this state, as contemplated by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
- 3. Lowe misappropriated, converted to his own use, or illegally withheld money belonging to an insured, insurer, or beneficiary, in violation of Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(4).
- 4. Lowe engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices in violation of Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 5. Pursuant to Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021(c)-(d), the commissioner may deny Lowe's application and consider him to have been convicted of an offense for which he received deferred adjudication, if after consideration of the factors in Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.022 and 53.023(a), the commissioner determines that:
  - a. Lowe has not completed his period of supervision; or

- b. Lowe completed his period of supervision less than five years before the date he applied for the license; and
- c. Employment of Lowe in the licensed occupation would create a situation in which Lowe has an opportunity to repeat the prohibited conduct.
- 6. Department guidelines, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c) and (d), emphasize the department:
  - i. considers it very important that applicants be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
  - ii. may refuse to issue a license if the department determines the applicant has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
  - iii. considers any offense for which fraud, dishonesty, deceit, or theft is an essential element to be of prime importance when determining fitness for licensure.
- 7. Lowe had his individual agent license and his agency licensed revoked and has failed to show good cause why the 2012 license revocations should not be deemed as a bar to issuance of a new license as required by Tex. INS. CODE § 4005.105(c).

### **Relief Sought**

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Leonard Paul Lowe's license application; and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
