General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Michael F. Carranza (Respondent) because he submitted fictitious information to an insurance company on numerous applications to obtain commissions and failed to respond to the department's inquiries. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- 1. On August 19, 2022, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Sinton, TX 78387-5440. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition was also sent by electronic mail.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4054.051; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 Tex. Admin. Code § 1.502; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Michael F. Carranza. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

- Michael F. Carranza (Carranza) was issued a general lines agent license with a qualification in life, accident, health, and HMO by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) on February 9, 2010.
- 2. On December 16, 2020, TDI received information that Carranza submitted insurance applications to American Family Life Assurance Company (AFLAC) containing fictitious information.
- 3. On April 19, 2018, Carranza submitted three applications for "Victor Cervantes" and two applications for "Josh Anderson" who were found to be fictitious persons based on the information provided in the applications. These policies were added to an AFLAC account for GCR Tires and Service BPF in Columbus, GA, who could not verify employment for the named policyholders.

- 4. On May 1, 2018, Carranza submitted two applications for "Chad Johnson" and two applications for "Jay Luna", both listed as prison guards, who were found to be fictitious persons based on the information provided in the applications. These polices were added to an AFLAC account for a Criminal Justice San Diego in Forston, GA, who indicated they had no employment records for the named policyholders.
- 5. On May 16, 2018, Carranza submitted three applications for "Nathan Lopez", three applications for "Rodolpho Mata", two applications for "Miguel Torres", and two applications for "Douglas Williams", all listed as prison guards and found to be fictitious persons based on the information provided in the applications. These policies were added to the AFLAC account for Criminal Justice San Diego in Forston, GA, who indicated they had no employment records for these four policyholders.
- 6. Carranza received \$3,723 in unearned commissions as a result of the fictitious policy applications. AFLAC was not able to recover the unearned commissions from Carranza.
- 7. On August 11, 2021, May 11, 2022, and June 7, 2022, TDI sent inquiries to Carranza requesting information regarding the matter. Carranza failed to respond to the inquiries.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Carranza committed acts for which a license holder may be disciplined under Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101, as contemplated in Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.102.
- 2. Carranza engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 3. Carranza failed to respond to the departments inquiry, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 38.001.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Carranza's license; and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law.
