General remarks and official action taken:

This is a default order taken against Benjamin Roth Robertson (Respondent) because Respondent engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices and Respondent did not notify the department of the administrative actions taken against him. Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order revokes Respondent's license.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- 1. On December 15, 2022, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- 3. The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, Fort Worth, Texas 76179-3827.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4001.252, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. Code § 82.055; and 28 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054, and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to take disciplinary action against Benjamin Roth Robertson. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under Tex. Ins. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, 4001.002, 4001.252, 4005.101, 4005.102, and 4054.051, and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Licensure and Background

- 1. Benjamin Roth Robertson (Robertson), individual identification number 577382, holds a general lines agent license with a life, accident, and health qualification originally issued by the Texas Department of Insurance on April 21, 2004.
- 2. Robertson was appointed as an agent with UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company (UnitedHealthcare) from September 2017, through October 2020.
- 3. Robertson was appointed as an agent with the Chesapeake Life Insurance Company (Chesapeake) from March 2017 through February 2021.

Misconduct

- 4. UnitedHealthcare received a consumer complaint alleging Robertson forged her signature on an application for insurance and submitted it without her knowledge or consent.
- 5. UnitedHealthcare subsequently investigated Robertson's sales and marketing practices. Based on its investigation, UnitedHealthcare believes Robertson violated company policy and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services regulations and guidelines while marketing and selling federal insurance products.
- 6. On October 7, 2020, UnitedHealthcare cancelled Robertson's appointments.
- 7. After UnitedHealthcare's Disciplinary Action Committee, Chesapeake learned Robertson's appointment with UnitedHealthcare was terminated for cause due to an allegation of forgery. Chesapeake then conducted its own investigation into Robertson's conduct.
- 8. Chesapeake's investigation revealed Robertson wrote 42 applications for insurance between February 2020 and September 2020. Robertson used 11 different Text Now phone numbers as the applicant's mobile phone number. Text Now is a free application available through Apple, Google Play, and its website The applications also contained an email address that did not belong to the applicants. Robertson wrote seven applications with an applicant's email address containing the name "pool.jessica." Most of the applications were signed electronically in Fort Worth, Texas, where Robertson resides even though most of the applicants resided in a different state.
- 9. In response to the companies and the department, Robertson claims a former assistant, Jessica Poole, is to blame for the alleged misconduct. Robertson largely denied having any knowledge of what Text Now is and claimed he only used phone numbers obtained from the applicants.
- 10. On February 16, 2021, Chesapeake cancelled Robertson's appointment.

Other State Administrative Actions

- 11. On November 10, 2020, the South Carolina Department of Insurance issued a consent order against Robertson which ordered him to pay a \$500 monetary penalty and placed his license on probation for a one-year period. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.
- 12. On January 8, 2021, the North Carolina Department of Insurance entered into a settlement with Robertson after a complaint investigation which ordered him to pay a \$500 monetary penalty. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.
- 13. On July 1, 2021, the Illinois Department of Insurance issued Robertson a license with a probated suspension and ordered Robertson to pay a \$500 monetary penalty. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.
- 14. On July 8, 2021, the Utah Insurance Department accepted a voluntary surrender from Robertson after a complaint investigation. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.
- 15. On July 30, 2021, the Nebraska Department of insurance revoked Robertson's license because he submitted applications for insurance policies with fraudulent or incorrect information included. The misconduct at issue in Nebraska is similar to the alleged misconduct at issue in the current case with the department. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.
- 16. On February 8, 2022, the Wisconsin Office of the Commissioner of Insurance denied Robertson's application for licensure due to his failure to disclose administrative actions taken in any state on the license application. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.
- 17. On July 15, 2022, the North Carolina Department of Insurance entered into a settlement with Robertson after a complaint investigation which ordered him to pay a \$250 monetary penalty. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.

18. On August 30, 2022, the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation revoked Robertson's license after he failed to respond. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative action.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Robertson committed acts for which a license holder may be disciplined under TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.102.
- 2. Robertson willfully violated an insurance law of this state, as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(1).
- 3. Robertson engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b)(5).
- 4. Robertson did not notify the department of the administrative actions taken against him, in violation of Tex. INS. CODE § 4001.252.

Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. revoking Benjamin Roth Robertson's general lines agent license; and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
