#### General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether a non-resident general lines agent license should be issued to Mario Santana (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance. This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

#### **Findings of Fact**

#### Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- On April 28, 2023, the department filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. The department's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.
- The department sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the departmen

Vero Beach, FL 32968-4038. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were also sent by electronic mail and to one additional address associated with Respondent:

Vero Beach, FL 32967.

4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including Tex. Ins. Code §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4054.051, and 4056.052; 28 Tex. ADMIN. Code § 1.502; Tex. Occ. Code §§ 53.021–53.023; and Tex. Gov't Code §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under Tex. Gov'T CODE § 2001.056; Tex. Ins. CODE § 82.055; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. The department provided proper notice of the hearing under Tex. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054; and 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, the department is entitled to disposition by default under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. The department's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.

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#### Order

It is ordered that Mario Santana's application is denied. A copy of this order will be provided to law enforcement or other appropriate administrative agencies for further investigation as may be warranted.

#### ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance seeks to deny Mario Santana's license application. In support of this petition, the department makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

#### Jurisdiction

The Commissioner of Insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under Tex. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4054.051, and 4056.052, 28 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502, TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021–53.023, and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

#### **Factual Allegations**

# License Application and Background

- 1. On October 26, 2020, Mario Santana (Santana) applied for a non-resident general lines agent license with a life, accident, health, and HMO qualification to be issued by the department. He previously held a non-resident general lines agent license with a life, accident, health and HMO qualification issued by the department on November 9, 2017, and which expired on August 31, 2019, because he failed to renew it.
- 2. Santana resides in Florida and according to the records of the Florida Department of Financial Services, Division of Insurance Agent and Agency Services (FDFS), he holds a Florida insurance license, but has no active appointments in Florida.

- 3. On December 9, 2020, the department proposed to deny Santana's application because he had been the subject of administrative disciplinary proceedings by insurance regulators in other states and because of his criminal history.
- 4. Santana appealed that decision and made a written request for a hearing.

<u>Disciplinary Actions Taken by Insurance Regulators in Florida, Louisiana, Delaware, and Virginia</u>

- 5. On January 9, 2018, the Chief Financial Officer of Florida, who oversees the FDFS, entered a Consent Order in Case No. 179565-17-AG. The order found that Santana had knowingly submitted insurance applications with false information to an insurer, fined him \$5,000 and ordered Santana to cease and desist from that conduct.
- 6. On July 12, 2018, the Louisiana Commissioner of Insurance entered a default order revoking Santana's insurance license for failing to report the Florida order to Louisiana, failing to respond to Louisiana's inquiry, and failing to respond to Louisiana's Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action.
- 7. On December 17, 2018, in Case No. 167005, the Delaware Insurance Commissioner entered a default order revoking Santana's insurance license for failing to report the Florida order to Delaware, and failing to respond to Delaware's Complaint and Notice of Hearing against him.
- 8. On July 3, 2020, in Case No. INS-2020-00109, the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) entered a default order revoking Santana's insurance license for failing to report the Florida, Louisiana, and Delaware administrative actions to the Virginia SCC, and failing to respond to the Virginia SCC's notification of his right to hearing regarding his failure to report.
- 9. The orders from the insurance regulators in the states of Florida, Louisiana, Delaware, Virginia, and Ohio (discussed below) demonstrate that Santana has committed numerous fraudulent or dishonest acts.

## Post-Application Disciplinary History and Failure to Respond to TDI

- 10. On May 12, 2021, the department requested additional information about his application from Santana, but he failed to respond to the request.
- 11. On October 19, 2021, the Superintendent of the Ohio Department of Insurance (Ohio DOI) issued a default order revoking Santana's insurance license because Santana submitted a renewal application in which he falsely answered "No" to the question "Have you ever been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding . . . regarding any professional . . . license," when he had, at that time, been the subject of such proceedings by both Louisiana and Delaware. Santana failed to respond to the Ohio DOI's Notice of Intent to Suspend, Revoke, or Refuse to Renew his Nonresident Agent License.
- 12. On March 20 and March 21, 2023, the department requested additional information about his application from Santana, but he failed to respond to any of the requests.

#### **Legal Allegations**

1. Santana has committed multiple acts for which a license may be denied pursuant to Tex. Ins. Code §§ 4005.101-4005.102 because he engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, as contemplated by Tex. Ins. Code § 4005.101(b)(5).

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## **Relief Sought**

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, the department asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the Commissioner of Insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Mario Santana's license application; and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
