General remarks and official action taken:

The subject of this default order is whether an all-lines adjuster license should be issued to Emma Simmons (Respondent). Respondent did not respond to a Notice of Hearing filed by the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI). This order denies Respondent's license application.

The following findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted:

Findings of Fact

Failure to Respond to Notice of Hearing

- 1. On October 16, 2023, TDI filed a Notice of Hearing, attached as Exhibit A, and an Original Petition, attached as Exhibit B, with the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 2. TDI's factual allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order as findings of fact.

- TDI sent the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition to Respondent's last known address provided in writing to the department, for the department, for the Arlington, TX 76016. The Notice of Hearing and Original Petition was also sent by electronic mail.
- 4. Respondent failed to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing within 20 days of the date the Notice of Hearing and Original Petition were mailed.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The commissioner has jurisdiction under Texas law, including TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4001.102, 4001.105, 4005.101-4005.105, and 4101.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.
- 2. The commissioner has authority to dispose of this case informally under TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056; TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055; and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.47, 1.88, and 1.89.
- 3. TDI provided proper notice of the hearing under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.28, 1.88, 1.89, and 19.906; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051, 2001.052, and 2001.054.
- 4. Based on Respondent's failure to file a written response to the Notice of Hearing, TDI is entitled to disposition by default under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 1.88 and 1.89.
- 5. TDI's factual and legal allegations set out in the attached Notice of Hearing and Original Petition are incorporated in this order and deemed admitted as true under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.89.



ORIGINAL PETITION

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) seeks to deny Emma Simmons' license application. In support of this petition, TDI makes the following allegations upon information and belief:

Jurisdiction

The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 4001.002, 4005.101, 4005.102, 4101.051; TEX. OCC. CODE §§ 53.021-53.023; 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502; and TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 2001.051-2001.178.

Factual Allegations

Application

- 1. On August 18, 2021, Emma Simmons (Simmons) submitted an application for a resident all-lines adjuster license to TDI.
- 2. The second question on the application reads:

"Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?"

Simmons falsely answered:

"No".

EXHIBIT B

- 3. On October 14, 2021 and December 6, 2021, Simmons responded to TDI's second and third requests for statements on the events surrounding her crime. Simmons statements were elusive and inconsistent with court documents related to the crime.
- 4. On or about November 3, 2021, Simmons responded to TDI's request for a resume indicating that she has been working as an auto claims adjuster in the insurance industry since August 2020.
- 5. On December 13, 2021, TDI sent a letter to Simmons denying her application based on her criminal history, her failure to disclose that history on her application, and additional concerns related to transparency and current conduct. Simmons made a timely request for a hearing on this matter.

Criminal History

- 6. On December 9, 2015, Simmons pleaded guilty to theft by taking, a felony offense, in case number 154179 in the Cobb County Superior Court of Georgia. Final judgement was deferred pending the outcome of a 10-year probationary period.
- 7. The theft in Simmons' guilty plea arose from prior employment where she was entrusted with collecting money from consumers.
- 8. Simmons is on probation until December 8, 2025.

Legal Allegations

- 1. Simmons' license application may be denied under 4005.102(1)(A), for committing the following acts in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.101(b):
 - a. Simmons engaged in fraudulent or dishonest conduct as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.01(b)(5);
 - b. Simmons attempted to obtain a license by misrepresentation as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.01(b)(3);
 - c. Simmons intentionally made a material misstatement in the license application as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.01(b)(2); and

- d. Simmons willfully violated an insurance law of this state as contemplated by TEX. INS. CODE § 4005.01(b)(1), by representing herself as an adjuster without a license, in violation of TEX. INS. CODE § 4101.051.
- 2. Simmons' license application may be denied under the TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021 because she has been convicted, for purposes of licensing¹, of an offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of an adjuster, as contemplated by TEX. OCC. CODE § 53.021(a)(1) and (d)(1)(B)(i), and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502 (d)(1).
- 3. Simmons committed an act that TDI considers to be of prime importance in determining fitness for licensure, as codified in TDI rules, namely:
 - a. an offense for which fraud, dishonesty, or deceit is an essential element, as contemplated under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(f)(1), and
 - b. an offense with the essential elements of theft, as contemplated under 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(f)(4)(K).
- 4. TDI guidelines, 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(c)-(e), emphasize that TDI:
 - a. considers it very important that the licensees be honest, trustworthy, and reliable;
 - b. may deny a license if TDI determines that the licensee has committed a felony or has engaged in fraudulent or dishonest activity that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; and
 - c. the factors listed in 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(h) do not outweigh the serious nature of Simmons' criminal offenses, as 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.502(f) contemplates.

¹ A licensing authority may consider a person who pleads guilty under a deferred adjudication program to have been convicted of the offense under certain conditions in accordance with Tex. Occ. CODE § 52.021 (d)(1)(B)(i).

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Relief Sought

If one or more of the above allegations is found to be true, TDI asks the Administrative Law Judge to enter a Proposal for Decision recommending that the commissioner of insurance issue an order:

- 1. denying Emma Simmons' license application, and
- 2. imposing any other just and appropriate relief to which the department may be entitled to by law, including any combination of the above actions.
