**General remarks and official action taken:**

This is a consent order with Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC. Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC failed to timely file surplus lines policies and related documents. Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC has agreed to pay an administrative penalty of \$67,150 for these violations.

**Waiver**

Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

**Findings of Fact**

1. Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC, license number 15929, holds a surplus lines agency license issued by the Texas Department of Insurance.
2. Pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a), a surplus lines insurance agent must file with the Surplus Lines Stamping Office of Texas either:
  - a. a copy of the policy issued or,

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- b. if the policy has not yet been issued, a copy of the certificate, cover note, or other confirmation of insurance delivered to the insured.

This information is due not later than the 60th day after the later of the effective date or the issue date of new or renewal surplus lines insurance.

3. In 2023, Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC filed surplus lines policies and related documents late.
4. The commissioner previously disciplined Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 12-0106, entered on February 6, 2012.
5. The commissioner previously disciplined Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 2017-5280, entered on November 14, 2017.
6. The commissioner previously disciplined Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 2018-5749, entered on December 12, 2018.
7. The commissioner previously disciplined Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 2022-7199, entered on February 1, 2022.
8. The commissioner previously disciplined Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC for violating TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) in Official Order No. 2023-8304, entered on October 26, 2023.

## Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner of insurance has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051-82.055, 84.021-84.044, and 981.105.
2. The commissioner of insurance has authority to informally dispose of this matter under TEX. INS. CODE § 82.055, TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056, and 28 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 1.47.
3. Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this

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
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order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.


4. Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC violated TEX. INS. CODE § 981.105(a) by failing to timely file new or renewal surplus lines policies and related documents.

## Order

It is ordered that Alliant Insurance Services Houston LLC must pay an administrative penalty of \$67,150 within 30 days from the date of this order. The administrative penalty must be paid as instructed in the invoice, which the department will send after entry of this order.


