General remarks and official action taken:

This is a consent order with Hillel Muller (Muller). Muller closed eight transactions while his escrow license was inactive. Muller has agreed to an administrative penalty of \$25,000 for these violations.

Waiver

Muller acknowledges that the Texas Insurance Code and other applicable law provide certain rights. Muller waives all of these rights, and any other applicable procedural rights, in consideration of the entry of this consent order.

Findings of Fact

1. Muller, individual identification number 2514518, holds an escrow officer license issued by TDI on October 22, 2025.
2. Muller's original escrow license was issued on April 28, 2022, but expired on March 31, 2024, without renewal. His escrow officer license remained inactive from March 31, 2024, until its reinstatement on October 22, 2025.

3. Executive Premier Title, LLC (Executive Premier Title), organization identification number 190576, holds a title agency license issued by TDI on April 28, 2022.
4. Muller was the only employee and escrow officer at Executive Premier Title between March 31, 2024, to October 22, 2025.
5. During the time Muller's license was inactive, Muller closed eight real estate transactions with Executive Premier Title.
6. The eight transactions Muller closed while his license was inactive resulted in \$359,321 in title charges paid to Executive Premier Title.
7. Executive Premier terminated Muller's employment on November 7, 2025.

Conclusions of Law

1. The commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter under TEX. INS. CODE §§ 82.051–82.055, 84.021–84.044, 2652.001, and 2652.201.
2. The commissioner has the authority to informally dispose of this matter as set forth in TEX. GOV'T CODE § 2001.056, and TEX. INS. CODE §§ 36.104 and 82.055.
3. Muller has knowingly and voluntarily waived all procedural rights to which it may have been entitled regarding the entry of this order, including, but not limited to, issuance and service of notice of intention to institute disciplinary action, notice of hearing, a public hearing, a proposal for decision, rehearing by the commissioner, and judicial review.
4. Muller violated TEX. INS. CODE § 2652.001 by acting as an escrow officer when his license was inactive.
5. Muller has willfully violated an insurance law of this state, as contemplated in TEX. INS. CODE § 2652.201(a)(1).



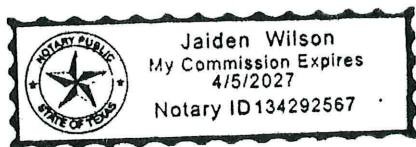
