State Fire Marshal Issues Reminder on Registration / License Numbers

In March 2012, the State Fire Marshal's Office began the conversion to a new licensing software program. For many companies and licensees, this resulted in being issued a new unique number. In order to lessen the impact of the changes, the State Fire Marshal's Office agreed that there would be a transition period of five (5) years to allow companies to deplete their stock of service tags and business forms bearing the old numbers.

As 2017 approaches, the State Fire Marshal's Office wants to issue this reminder that all items should now be displaying only your currently issued Registration and License numbers. This includes service tags, labels, vehicles, signs and business forms. After March 1, 2017, the old numbers must not be used or displayed.

The State Fire Marshal's Office wants to thank everyone for your patience and cooperation through this process. We understand the impact it had, both monetarily and in staff time. Based on comments received over the last four years, we believe the new system has proven to be worthwhile and resulted in better customer service.
