**Course Objectives:** The course combines classroom and hands-on training with practical exercises on how to conduct a systematic and accurate examination of burned vehicle. Extended focus will be given to signs of forced entry and manipulation of ignition and anti-theft systems and identifying normal conditions affected by fire damage. Additional instruction will also be given to potential signs of arson and intentional tampering causing mechanical or electrical failures.

## **Upon Completion:** Participants will be able to:

- Understand vehicle design mechanical and electrical systems and vehicle immobilizers
- Apply knowledge of potential arson motives and possible fire causes
- Apply knowledge of normal conditions affected by fire and intentional tampering prior to fire development
- Document, photograph and collect evidence from the fire scene
- Investigate in accordance with NFPA 921 and 1033
- Apply the scientific method, while examining and reporting the investigation process
