Individual Application for a Pyrotechnic, Special Effects, and Flame Effects Operator's License

Instructions

- Print or type your information.
- Include all required test and certification documents as indicated on the Fireworks License and Test Information Guide [SF238](#). These requirements are in [Chapter 2154 of the Texas Occupations Code](#) and [Section 34.800 of the Texas Administrative Code, Title 28, the Fireworks Rules](#).
- A pyrotechnic operator's license shall not be issued to any person who is under 21 years of age.
- Pyrotechnic operator license applicants must complete page 5.
- Do not submit your application until you have met all test requirements. Test scores are valid for one year from the date the test was taken.
- All fees are nonrefundable, except for overpayments from mistakes of law or fact.
- Send one payment to cover fees. Payments for various applications must be combined.
- Answer questions completely and truthfully. We may deny, suspend, or revoke your license if you misrepresent or knowingly give wrong information on this application.
