- \_\_\_ Allow adjuster to view the damage.
- \_\_\_ Settle claim with your insurance company.
- \_\_\_ Pay deductible (this is your first claim and you have not paid a deductible yet).
- \_\_\_ Receive valid insurance card from insurance company.
