Requestor's Position

"The above claimant received medication as prescribed by the referral provider. Bill for date of 07/28/2023 was processed on 08/27/2023. The explanation of benefits indicated that the carrier allowed \$29.94. However, as of 01/03/2023, Memorial Wellness Pharmacy has not received a check for this date of service."

Amount in Dispute: \$29.93

Respondent's Position

The Austin carrier representative for Illinois National Insurance Co is Flahive Ogden & Latson. Flahive Ogden & Latson was notified of this medical fee dispute on April 16, 2024. Rule §133.307(d)(1) states that if the division does not receive the response within 14 calendar days of the dispute notification, then the division may base its decision on the available information. As of today, no response has been received from the carrier or its representative. We therefore base this decision on the information available as authorized under 28 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §133.307(d)(1).

Findings and Decision

Authority

This medical fee dispute is decided according to Texas Labor Code §413.031 and applicable rules of the Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC).

Statutes and Rules

1. 28 TAC [§133.307](#) sets out the procedures for resolving medical fee disputes.
2. 28 TAC [§134.503](#) sets out the pharmacy fee guideline.

Denial Reasons

The insurance denied the payment for the disputed services with the following claim adjustment codes:

- 18 – Exact duplicate claim/service
- 83 – Claim previously processed
- P12 – Workers' compensation jurisdictional fee schedule adjustment

Issues

1. Is Memorial Wellness Pharmacy entitled to reimbursement?

Findings

1. Memorial Wellness Pharmacy is requesting reimbursement for Hydrocodone, NDC No. 53746010905 dispensed on July 28, 2023.

DWC Rule 28 TAC §134.503(c)(1)(A) states

The insurance carrier shall reimburse the health care provider or pharmacy processing agent for prescription drugs the lesser of:

- (1) the fee established by the following formulas based on the average wholesale price (AWP) as reported by a nationally recognized pharmaceutical price guide or other publication of pharmaceutical pricing data in effect on the day the prescription drug is dispensed:

(A) Generic drugs: $((\text{AWP per unit}) \times (\text{number of units}) \times 1.25) + \4.00 dispensing fee per prescription = reimbursement amount;

The total reimbursement is \$29.93. This amount is recommended.

Conclusion

The outcome of this medical fee dispute is based on the evidence presented by the requestor and the respondent at the time of adjudication. Though all evidence may not have been discussed, it was considered.

DWC finds the requester has established that reimbursement of \$29.93 is due.

Order

Under Texas Labor Code §§413.031 and 413.019, DWC has determined the requestor is entitled to reimbursement for the disputed services. It is ordered that Illinois National Insurance Co must remit to Memorial Wellness Pharmacy \$29.93 plus applicable accrued interest within 30 days of receiving this order in accordance with 28 TAC §134.130.
