Extension of Emergency Adjuster License Period

General remarks and official action taken:

As authorized under Insurance Code § 4101.101(d), the commissioner of insurance extends the license term of emergency adjusters whose applications TDI has received or will receive between August 25, 2017, and December 31, 2017, for an additional 90-day period, creating an effective license period of 180 days from the date the license was issued. This action is taken for the following reasons:

- 1. As determined by Governor Abbott in his disaster proclamation of August 23, 2017, which was subsequently amended on August 26, August 27, August 28, September 14, September 20, and October 20, 2017, Hurricane Harvey caused catastrophic damage to 60 Texas counties;
- 2. Hurricane Harvey resulted in a significant number of losses in Texas. Insurers are continuing to process those claims and losses;
- 3. Insurance Code § 4101.101(d) authorizes the commissioner to extend the emergency adjuster license term for 90 days, creating an effective period of 180 days from the date the license was issued; and
- 4. Extension of the license term for an additional 90-day period for emergency adjusters whose applications TDI has received or will receive between August 25, 2017, and December 31, 2017, is appropriate.
