

Informal Working Draft and Request for Informal Comments on Consumer Bill of Rights for Homeowners, Dwelling, and Renters Insurance

28 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Subchapter W, Sections 5.9970 and 5.9971

The Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) is seeking comments on an informal working draft of a rule that would:

- create a new rule for the Consumer Bill of Rights for Homeowners, Dwelling, and Renters Insurance separate and apart from the rule for Consumer Bill of Rights for Personal Automobile Insurance; and
- update the homeowner consumer bill of rights and make it easier to read.

The Office of Public Insurance Counsel submitted the revised Bill of Rights to TDI under Insurance Code Section 501.156.

TDI posts this informal working draft to gather and consider information from the public, and we invite you to comment on it. This is not a formal publication for rulemaking. TDI is particularly interested in specific anticipated costs (if any) of compliance with the rule.
