Item P-1420—Establishment of Notification Endorsement of Pending Law Change to Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2019

Description:

- NCCI says that the endorsement proposed in this filing would notify policyholders that:
 - the Terrorism Risk Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2019 (TRIPRA) will expire on December 31, 2027, unless reauthorized;
 - TRIPRA may be extended in the same form or some other form; and
 - their premium for terrorism loss coverage may change.
- NCCI proposed that the changes be effective for new and renewal workers' compensation policies issued on or after 12:01 a.m. on January 1, 2027, and any in-force policies as of December 31, 2026.
- Per Commissioner's Order No. 3142, dated March 21, 2014, the commissioner may issue an order approving the filing, approving the filing with changes, or rejecting the filing.
