RE: Revised Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Forms

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) has adopted revisions to these forms:

- EDI-01, Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Trading Partner Profile; and
- EDI-02, Insurance Carrier or Trading Partner Medical Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Profile.

We posted the draft forms online from March 8, 2022, to March 22, 2022.

Texas Labor Code Sections 411.032 and 413.007 require insurance carriers to report claim and medical billing information to DWC. These forms allow insurance carriers and trading partners to update their trading partner profiles for claim and medical EDI release 1.0 data submissions and designate their medical EDI compliance coordinators.

The revisions update the forms to meet new DWC form standards. We will update the EDI-01 form after rule amendments that require insurance carriers to report claim EDI in the release 3.1 format go into effect.

Parties may use the adopted forms immediately. The forms are on the <u>TDI website</u>.
