RE: Review of "Old Law" Rules Title 28, Texas Administrative Code, Chapters 41-69

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) is readopting all sections within the "Old Law" chapters, Chapters 41-69, of Title 28, Part 2 of the Texas Administrative Code. This readoption is in compliance with Texas Government Code §2001.039, which requires a state agency to review each of its rules every four years and to readopt, readopt with amendment, or repeal the rule. A notice of rule review was published in the April 5, 2019, issue of the Texas Register (44 Tex. Reg. 1719 (2019)).

DWC received eight comments on the review. The comments support readopting the rules and propose amending the medical fee guidelines.

Any repeals or suggested amendments identified during the review of these rules may be considered in future rulemaking in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 2001.
