RE: Proposed Amendments to 28 TAC §133.307

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) is accepting public comments on a proposed rule amending 28 Texas Administrative Code §133.307 to allow health care providers and pharmacy processing agents to electronically submit requests for medical fee dispute resolution (MFDR).

DWC specifically requests comments on whether we should accept MFDR requests submitted by email.
