Send in your WPI-2s!

Don't forget to submit your completed and signed Inspection Verification Form, WPI-2, after your inspection. Even if you enter the inspection online, you must submit a copy of the signed form for TDI to issue the Certificate of Compliance.

Ongoing Improvements

The inspector performed the initial inspections before

- the original title transferred from the builder to the initial owner; or
- the improvement entered the final framing stage of construction, including attachment of component and cladding items and installation of any impact resistant glazing or deliver of any wood or structural panels.

Submit inspection verification form (WPI-2), for ongoing improvements to the Texas Department of Insurance and receive a Certificate of Compliance (WPI-8).

Completed Improvements

The inspector performed the initial inspection after

- the original title transferred from the builder to the initial owner; or
- the improvement entered the final framing stage of construction, including attachment of component and cladding items and installation of any impact resistant glazing or deliver of any wood or structural panels.

Submit inspection verification and request for certificate of compliance for completed improvements form (WPI-3), for completed improvements to the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association and receive a Certificate of Compliance (WPI-8-C)
