### **Installation:**

### System 1

**Option 1:** The wood wall framing members must be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window frame is secured to the wall framing with No. 8 x 2-1/2" screws. Locate the screws approximately 6" from each corner and 15" on center. Fasteners must be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing members.

**Option 2:** The wood wall framing members must be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window frame is secured to the wall framing with structural brackets (1-9/16"  $\times$  6-1/2"  $\times$  0.050"). Locate the brackets approximately 6" from each corner and 15" on center. Each bracket is secured to the window frame with two No. 8  $\times$  5/8" screws and to the wall framing interior and exterior with two No. 8 screws. Fasteners must be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing members.

**System 2:** The wood wall framing members must be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window frame is secured to the wall framing with structural brackets (1-9/16"  $\times$  6-1/2"  $\times$  0.050"). Locate the brackets approximately 6" from each corner and 15" on center. Each bracket is secured to the window frame with two No. 8  $\times$  5/8" screws and to the wall framing interior and exterior with two No. 8 screws. Fasteners must be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing members.

**System 3:** The wood wall framing members must be minimum Spruce-Pine-Fir dimension lumber. The window frame is secured to the wall framing with No. 8 x 2-1/2" screws. Locate the screws approximately 6" from each corner and 15" on center, 4" below springline along the side jambs, 1-1/2" above springline, at 1/4 points and 1/2 points of radius along the head. Fasteners must be long enough to penetrate a minimum of 1-1/2" into the wall framing members.

**Note:** Keep the manufacturer's installation instructions available on the job site during installation. Use corrosion resistant fasteners as specified in the IRC and the IBC.
